The Herb Society of Nashville's annual Herb Day features two exciting speakers:

John Forti, a nationally recognized garden historian, ethnobotanist and herbalist, is the Curator of Historic Gardens and Landscapes at Strawberry Banke Museum in Portsmouth, NH. John regularly contributes to gardening, lifestyle, and food publications, and is featured in television and radio programs.

Nancy Vienneau, an author and educator, advocates healthy cooking practices using fresh, seasonal foods from local farmers. Nancy writes restaurant reviews for *The Tennessean*, authored "The Catering Chronicles, A Comet's Tail of Chocolate." She also teaches at the Second Harvest Food Bank's Culinary Arts Center.

Garden related vendors will offer charming wares and useful products, and artistic members of The Herb Society of Nashville will display samples of their many talents.

The cost for the day, which includes a casual, picnic lunch, is \$40. Cheekwood has agreed to waive the gate fee for attendees who wish only to attend Herb Day in Botanic Hall. However, if you wish to visit the spectacular Chihuly glass art exhibit and tour the gardens and museum, you may do so by showing your Cheekwood membership or paying a reduced admission fee of \$12.
